

GOOSEBERRY LAKE PROVINCIAL PARK

All those parcels or tracts of land, situate, lying, and being in the thirty-sixth (36) township, in the sixth (6) range, west of the fourth (4) meridian, in the Province of Alberta, Canada, and being composed of:

All those portions of the south half of section twenty-six (26) of the said township, and the statutory road allowance adjoining the south boundary thereof, not covered by any of the waters of Gooseberry Lake, as shown upon a map or plan of survey of the said township approved and confirmed at Ottawa on the fifteenth (15) day of November, nineteen hundred and five (1905), by E. Deville, Surveyor General of Dominion Lands, and on file in the Department of Lands and Forests at Edmonton.

The lands herein described containing one hundred and twenty-eight (128.0) acres, more or less.
