

LITTLE FISH LAKE PROVINCIAL PARK

All those parcels or tracts of land, situate, lying, and being in the twenty-eighth (28) township, in the sixteenth (16) range, west of the fourth (4) meridian, in the Province of Alberta, Canada, and being composed of:

All those portions of the north west quarter of section four (4) and the south west quarter of section nine (9) of the said township not covered by any of the waters of Little Fish Lake, as shown upon a map or plan of survey of the said township approved and confirmed at Ottawa on the thirty-first (31) day of March, nineteen hundred and nine (1909), by E. Deville, Surveyor General of Dominion Lands, and on file in the Department of Lands and Forests at Edmonton, containing one hundred and sixty and four tenths (160.4) acres, more or less.

SAVING AND EXCEPTING:

Three and seventy-one hundredths (3.71) acres, more or less, out of the said north west quarter of section four (4) and five and forty-eight hundredths (5.48) acres, more or less, out the the said south west quarter of section nine (9), required for a surveyed roadway, as shown upon a plan of survey of the said roadway of record in the said Department of Lands and Forests as No. 430 R.D.

The lands herein described containing by admeasurement one hundred and fifty-one and twenty-one hundredths (151.21) acres, more or less.
