

WILLIAMSON PROVINCIAL PARK

Lot one (1) in township seventy (70), range twenty-four (24), west of the fifth (5) meridian, in the Province of Alberta, Canada, described as follows:

Commencing at a wooden post and trench at the intersection of the south shore of Sturgeon Lake; thence on a bearing of two hundred twelve (212) degrees and thirty-nine (39) minutes a distance of nineteen (19) chains and sixty (60) links to a wooden post and trench; thence on a bearing of three hundred two (302) degrees and thirty-nine (39) minutes a distance of twenty (20) chains to a wooden post; thence on a bearing of thirty-two (32) degrees and thirty-nine (39) minutes to the intersection of the said south shore of the said lake; thence southeasterly along the said south shore to the point of commencement as shown upon a map or plan of survey of the said township approved and confirmed at Ottawa on the fifth (5) day of January, nineteen hundred and fourteen (1914) by E. Deville, Surveyor General of Dominion Lands, and on file in the Department of Lands and Forests at Edmonton containing forty-seven and forty hundredths (47.40) acres, more or less.

SAVING AND EXCEPTING:

- (1) Two and seventy-eight hundredths (2.78) acres, more or less, required for a surveyed roadway, as shown upon a plan of survey on file in the Land Titles Office at Edmonton for the North Alberta Land Registration District as No. 3287 E.U.
- (2) One and seventy-four hundredths (1.74) acres, more or less, required for a surveyed roadway, as shown upon a plan of survey of record in the said Department of Lands and Forests as No. 5687 R.D., and on file in the said Land Titles Office as No. 3755 P.X.

The land herein described containing forty-two and eighty-eight hundredths (42.88) acres, more or less.
