

## HIGHWOOD JUNCTION PROVINCIAL RECREATION AREA

All that parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in the unsurveyed sixteenth (16) township, in the fifth (5) range, west of the fifth (5) meridian, in the Province of Alberta, Canada, and being composed of:

All that portion of the north half of section twenty-nine (29) of the said township, as shown upon a plan on file in the Department of Environmental Protection at Edmonton as No. P0062 M.L. being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the westerly limit of Highway No. 940 distant seventy (70) metres (217 feet) southerly along the said westerly limit from its intersection with the southerly limit of Highway No. 40; thence southerly along the said westerly limit a distance of one hundred twenty-three (123) metres (381.3 feet); thence westerly and at right angle to the last described course a distance of thirty (30) metres (93 feet), thence southerly and at right angle to the last described course a distance of seventy (70) metres (217 feet); thence westerly and at right angle to the last described course a distance of two hundred eighty (280) metres (868 feet); thence northerly and at right angle to the last described course a distance of one hundred ninety-three (193) metres (598.3 feet); thence easterly and in a straight line to the point of commencement.
