

CROW LAKE ECOLOGICAL RESERVE

All those parcels or tracts of land, situate, lying and being in the seventy-eighth (78) township, in the fourteenth (14) range, west of the fourth (4) meridian, in the Province of Alberta, Canada, and being composed of: Sections twenty-eight (28) and twenty-nine (29), the north east quarter of section twenty-one (21), the south west guarter of section twenty-seven (27), and all those portions of section thirty (30) and the south halves of section thirty-one (31) and thirty-two (32) of the said township, lying generally to the south and east of Crow Lake and not covered by any of the waters of the said lake, containing nine hundred thirty eight and four hundred sixty six thousandths (938.466) hectares (2,319.00 acres), more or less.
