

Trails

Lowland Trail

4.5 km return trip

Easy trail provides scenic views of the Battle River and the Big Knife Hoodoos. Benches along the trail provide a place to relax and watch the many wildlife species attracted to the river environment.

Highland Trail

6.0 km return trip

Starting with a bit of an uphill climb that will get your heart pumping, this trail will take you to a viewpoint for panoramic views of the park and the beautiful Battle River valley.

Camping

The park has a mix of open and treed sites suitable for tents and RVs in a scenic parkland environment. There are also a few walk-in tenting sites nestled in the forest. Camping is all first-come, first-serve - no reservations.
