

ROAD CLOSURES

HIGHWAY #40:
Closed December 1st to June 14th inclusive
from Kananaskis Lakes Trail to the Highwood
House Junction.
FORESTRY TRUNK ROAD/HWY. #940:
Section South of Cataract Creek is closed
December 1st to April 30th inclusive.
HIGHWAY #532:
Closed December 1st to April 30th inclusive.
HIGHWAY #66:
Closed December 1st to May 14th inclusive
west of Elbow Falls, including Powderface Trail.
HIGHWAY #546:
Closed December 1st to May 14th inclusive
west of Sandy McNabb Campground.
MCLEAN CREEK TRAIL/ROAD:
Closed December 1st to April 30th inclusive.
POWDERFACE TRAIL/ROAD:
Closed December 1st to May 14th inclusive
south of Dawson.
GORGE CREEK TRAIL/ROAD:
Closed December 1st to May 14th inclusive.
Permanently closed between Ware Creek Day
Use and Gorge Creek Day Use.
MOOSE MOUNTAIN ROAD:
Closed December 1st to May 14th inclusive.



NOTES:

1. Equestrian use permitted.
2. Storage container for horse feed in the equestrian portion of the campground.
3. Operating dates may be modified due to snow or avalanche conditions.
4. Campground and/or access damaged in the 2013 flood. Repairs scheduled for Summer 2018. Opening dates and/or facilities may be altered.
5. Campground reservations may be considered outside of posted operation dates by phone or in-person reservation only
6. Campground scheduled for refurbishment in Spring/Summer 2018. Please call Kananaskis Information Line at 403-678-0760 to confirm availability.

Backcountry camping permits are required at all designated backcountry campgrounds in Kananaskis Country. Backcountry camping fees are used to offset the costs of the Kananaskis Country backcountry camping and trails programs. There is a maximum of 6 people permitted on each site, but only 1 tent is permitted per site. The only exceptions to the 1 tent per site rule are that Big Elbow, Romulus and Tombstone backcountry campgrounds permit 2 tents and that 2 hammock-style tents or 2 bivis are equivalent to 1 tent in all Kananaskis Country backcountry campgrounds.

People 16 years of age and older are required to pay for a backcountry camping permit. The permits are \$12.00 including GST per person per night. There is a \$12.00 Reservation fee applied To all telephone and advance bookings. People under 16 years of age require a permit to camp but there is no fee for the permit.

Permit requests can be submitted up to 90 days in advance of your stay via the Alberta Parks/Kananaskis Country website at: www.AlbertaParks.ca/kananaskis. Check the availability calendar prior to submitting your reservation request; once the request is processed a unique payment link will be emailed. Permits can also be purchased in person at the Barrier Lake and Elbow Valley Visitor Information Centres and the Peter Lougheed Park Discovery Centre during regular office hours. Campers and other outdoor enthusiasts should be aware that when the fire hazard is extreme, or when a fire situation is serious enough that it poses a danger to the public, travel restrictions and/or fire bans may be implemented. Restrictions are announced through various news media in the province and online at [www. AlbertaFireBans.ca](http://www.AlbertaFireBans.ca). Fire bans prohibit the lighting of all wood, briquette and propane/natural gas fires. Depending on the severity of the fire hazard, a fire ban may include fires contained in fire facilities in designated camping and recreation areas. Citronella candles and torches may also be prohibited during a fire ban. Gas-and liquid-fuelled cooking stoves are normally permitted during fire bans for cooking purposes only.
