Beautiful Sir Winston Churchill Provincial Park is Alberta's only park of islands. The main island, Big Island, is in the east basin of Lac La Biche. It is accessible by a 2.5 kilometre-long causeway and is just 11 kilometres northeast of the town of Lac La Biche.

The island offers groomed cross-country ski trails on the Loop Road of Big Island, and ice fishing opportunities on the lake.

Cabins #1–5 and Tipis #16–17

Closed for the winter season.

Comfort Camping Supplies

All cabins are equipped with dishes, glasses, cutlery, pots, pans, toaster, and drip coffeepot.

Pet Friendly Cabins

Cabins #8 and #9 are the only pet friendly cabins. Guests will be charged an additional \$20 per night per pet if pets are staying with them.

Maximum Occupancy by Cabin

Cabins 6–10: Maximum of 8 people
Cabins 11–15: Maximum of 6 people

Cabins #6–8

- 680 square feet, accessible for persons with disabilities.
- Bedroom one: queen-sized bed; bedroom two: three double mattresses in bunk bed layout; main living room: one pull-out futon (double bed size).
- Bathroom with toilet, sink and roll-in (accessible) shower.

Cabins #9–15

- 680 square feet.
- Units #9, #10 – bedroom one: queen-sized bed; bedroom two: three double mattresses in bunk bed layout; main living room: couch.
- Units #11-15 – bedroom one: queen-sized bed; bedroom two: two double mattresses in bunk bed layout; main living room: couch.
- Bathroom with toilet, sink and bathtub/shower.

Cabin Site Registration Building

- Allows campers to check-in at cabin site.
- Wi-Fi is available in cabins.

Rules

Check-in time is 4 p.m. Check-out time is 11 a.m.

Pets are not allowed inside comfort camping units aside from designated units, with the exception of registered service animals. Users of service animals should have government-issued identification cards for confirmation.

Smoking and/or vaping of tobacco and cannabis is strictly prohibited inside the unit and on the deck.

What to Bring

- Food and beverages
- Pillows and sleeping bags or duvets/blankets, sheets
- Towels, toiletries, hair dryer, etc.
- Flashlight
- Appropriate clothing and footwear, hat and sunglasses
- 30–50 foot extension cord for plugging in vehicles during winter
