

What to Expect with Comfort Camping Yurts

Get familiar with comfort camping at Pigeon Lake Provincial Park!



- Bookings can be made online or through the contact centre:
 https://reserve.albertaparks.ca/ or 1-877-537-2757
 - Comfort camping reservations can be made up to 180 days in advance of the scheduled arrival date.
- After you turn off Highway 771, follow the road about 1km to the entrance. It is on the left-hand side of the road.
- The entrance to the campground has a large sign that says Pigeon Lake Provincial Park. This is the entrance to the Day Use and campground.
- The speed limit at the entrance is **15km per hour.**
- Stay in the left-hand lane to check in at the booth.





- Check-in time is 4:00pm. Check-out time is 12:00pm.
- The reservation holder is the only person who can check-in for the yurts. Keys will not be given to anyone else.
- Check-ins should be completed by 7pm. If you will not make it before the booth closes, **you must let the campground know.**
- The reservation holder must sign an agreement at check-in.
